**18U consolation rounds will be wrestled with a 1 minute first round and 2 minute rounds thereafter.

Check-in, on-site registration, ****IF AVAILABLE****, and weigh-in will be held at the First Interstate Bank Arena Friday, March 28th only. Absolutely NO late registration or weigh-in will be permitted as this is a bout system tournament with assigned mat numbers and bout numbers. The ½ pound rule will be in effect for this tournament. Once in the weigh-in area, wrestlers will be allowed to cut weight only if they are within ½ pound. Check scales will be available.

Session I: 12, 15U, 18U, Open divisions: 5:30pm-8:30pm

Saturday, March 29 – Doors open at 7:00am. Opening ceremonies will begin at 8:15am with wrestling beginning immediately after.

Session II: 6U/8U/10U 845am-5:30pm

Session III: 12U/15U/18U/Open 6pm-9:30pm

Sunday, March 30 – Doors open at 8:00am. Wrestling begins at 9:00am for all remaining brackets, all ages.
